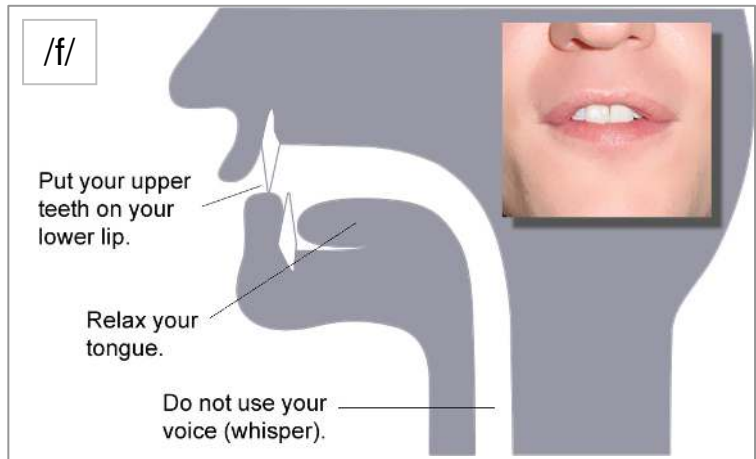

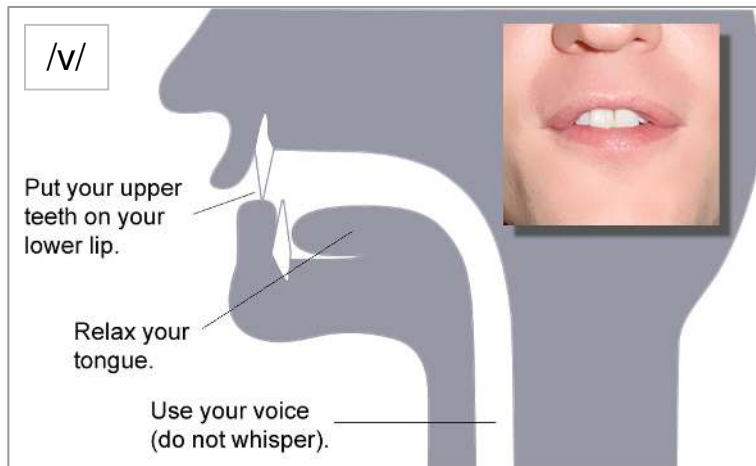

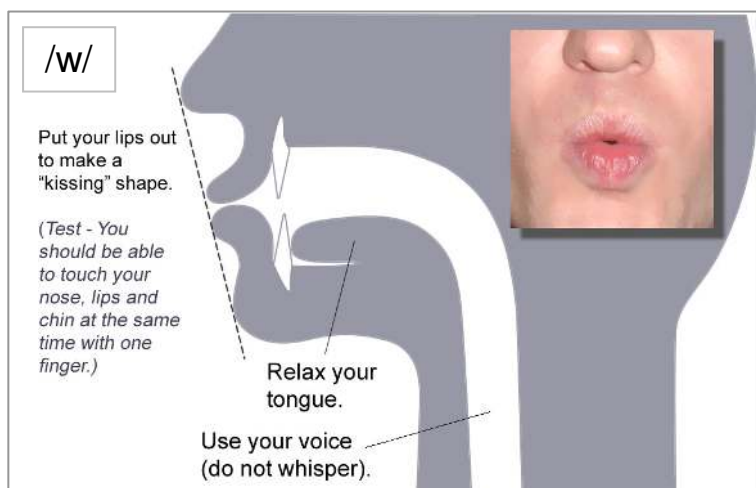

# Swim To Safety!

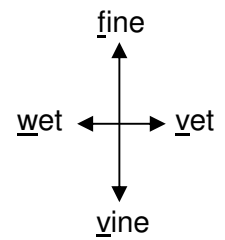

- **Next**, the teacher will tell you to swim up, down, left or right by saying the words "fine", "vine", "wet" or "vet". Listen carefully each time the teacher says a word and then swim one square in that direction.
- **At the end**, tell the teacher where you are by giving your final coordinates (e.g. 16B). The teacher will tell you if you are on the island or not. If you are on the island, you survived. If not, you are dead.
